The artist Mahssa Askari was born in Khoramshahr, Iran, in 1980. As a student of Prof. Herbert Brandl, she expresses the different cultures she experiences and the associated feelings in her pictures.

For the artist, her pictures are a mirror of life. "Life is both colorful and gray," is what the artist Mahssa Askari tries to convey in her motifs.

Color is the classic element of design in painting, which the artist specifically uses to use color in various mixing techniques and thereby significantly enhance the mood of her pictures. Narrative works are created that engage the viewer take you into the artist's world but leave everything open.

The motifs selected by Mahssa Askari are usually created through small collages or through preliminary studies. Especially with her large-format paintings, the artist loves to prepare for her large paintings on a small scale beforehand.
